After praying and carefully studying 1 Timothy 3:1-7 and Titus 1:6-9, I have come to the conclusion that has the qualifications checked below and that he should	
serve the church here as an elder.	
It is important to remember that while some of these qualifications are absolutes, and that one either is the husband of one wife or not, others of them are subjective and may be possessed to a greater or lesser degree. No man has ever possessed all of these qualifications in their full measure. Read each qualification, and then check to indicate that you believe the man whose name you submitted possesses that qualification.
